- \rightarrow Keep the action moving.



Session design

- S set a strategic intent
- T transition into the present, the body and the group

- R reflect on what happened
- I integrate into your practise





Three elements of Strategic Narrative Embodiment

- 1. Someone who wants something (a strategic intent)
- 2. Obstacles in their way (an embodied reality)
- 3. They try to get it anyway (the narrative/story)
